Re: State of Alaska revenues attributable to out-of-state visitors

Out-of-state visitors to Alaska resulted in an estimated \$193.1 million in State of Alaska revenues in 2025, as outlined in the following table. All figures reflect calendar year 2025. The largest sources of revenue were Alaska Railroad Corporation, Commercial Passenger Vessel excise tax, and Large Passenger Vessel Gambling tax.
